## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on Fungaflor 500 EC.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

### 3 **SECTION 1. FUNGAFLOR 500 EC.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.38.08	Fungaflor 500 EC, in preparation form, as a fungicide for citrus fruit (provided for in subheading 3808.20.15) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/02	”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the date that is 15 days after the date of the enactment  
5 of this Act.

6       (c) RETROACTIVE APPLICATION.—Notwithstanding  
7 section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514)  
8 or any other provision of law, upon proper request filed  
9 with the Customs Service on or before the date that is  
10 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, any  
11 entry, or withdrawal from warehouse for consumption, of  
12 goods described in subheading 3808.20.15 of the Har-  
13 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States—

14               (1) which was made after January 1, 1999, and  
15       before the date that is 15 days after the date of the  
16       enactment of this Act, and

17               (2) with respect to which there would have been  
18       no duty if the amendment made by subsection (a)  
19       applied to such entry or withdrawal,  
20 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as if such amendment  
21 applied to such entry or withdrawal.
