## A BILL

To impose a 2-year moratorium on the issuance of new Federal licenses to deal in firearms.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Firearms Proliferation
- 5 Prevention Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. MORATORIUM ON ISSUANCE OF NEW FEDERAL
- 7 FIREARMS DEALER LICENSES.
- 8 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding section 923 of
- 9 title 18, United States Code, the Secretary of the Treas-
- 10 ury may not issue a new license to deal in firearms during

- 1 the 2-year period that begins with the date of the enact-
- 2 ment of this Act.
- 3 (b) Inapplicability of Hearing Requirement.—
- 4 The first sentence of section 923(f)(2) of title 18, United
- 5 States Code, shall not apply to any application for a new
- 6 license to deal in firearms that is denied pursuant to sub-
- 7 section (a) of this section.
- 8 (c) Firearm Defined.—In this section, the term
- 9 'firearm' has the meaning given the term in section
- 10 921(a)(3) of title 18, United States Code.
