## A BILL

To amend section 107 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 to authorize the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development to make grants from community development block grant amounts to the Park and Recreation Commission, City of Youngstown, Ohio, for the construction of a community center and the renovation of a sports complex in such city.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Youngstown Commu-  
3 nity Center Development Act of 1999”.

4 **SEC. 2. CDBG SPECIAL PURPOSE GRANTS.**

5       Section 107(a)(1) of the Housing and Community  
6 Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5307(a)(1)) is  
7 amended—

8           (1) in the matter preceding subparagraph (A)—

9               (A) by striking “\$60,000,000” and insert-  
10           ing “\$104,000,000”; and

11               (B) by striking “subsection (b)” and in-  
12           serting “this section”; and

13           (2) by striking subparagraph (G) and inserting  
14   the following new subparagraph:

15               “(G) in fiscal year 2000—

16                   “(i) \$42,000,000 shall be available for  
17                   a grant to the Park and Recreation Com-  
18                   mission, City of Youngstown, Ohio, for the  
19                   construction of a community center in such  
20                   city; and

21                   “(ii) \$2,000,000 shall be available for  
22                   a grant to the Park and Recreation Com-  
23                   mission, City of Youngstown, Ohio, for the  
24                   renovation and refurbishing of the Sports

- 1 Complex (formerly known as South Field
- 2 House) in such city;”.
