## A BILL

For the relief of Elizabeth McKenney Padgett.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SURVIVOR BENEFIT PLAN ANNUITY FOR ELIZA-
- 4 BETH MCKENNEY PADGETT.
- 5 (a) ANNUITY.—The Secretary of the Army, subject
- 6 to subsection (b), shall pay to Elizabeth McKenney
- 7 Padgett, of Harrison Township, Michigan, an annuity
- 8 under the military Survivor Benefit Plan pursuant to the
- 9 election of her former husband, Sergeant Major Widford
- 10 D. Padgett (United States Army, retired) under section
- 11 1405 of Public Law 101–189 (10 U.S.C. 1448 note) with-
- 12 out regard to the provisions of subsection (g) of that sec-

- 1 tion, such annuity to be effective as of the day after the
- 2 death of Widford D. Padgett on February 10, 1993.
- 3 (b) Offset.—Payment of the annuity referred to in
- 4 subsection (a) shall be subject to a requirement for pay-
- 5 ment to the Secretary of an amount equal to the total
- 6 amount of SBP premiums that would have been paid by
- 7 Widford D. Padgett for the period beginning on the effec-
- 8 tive date of the election referred to in subsection (a) and
- 9 ending on the date two years later, determined as if he
- 10 had lived to the end of that period and otherwise had con-
- 11 tinued to receive retired pay during that period. Any such
- 12 payment may be made directly by Elizabeth McKenney
- 13 Padgett or may be made by offset from amounts that
- 14 would otherwise be payable under the annuity under sub-
- 15 section (a). Any such payment shall be credited in the
- 16 same manner as SBP premiums.
- 17 (c) Definitions.—For purposes of this section:
- 18 (1) MILITARY SURVIVOR BENEFIT PLAN.—The
- 19 term "military Survivor Benefit Plan" means the
- program established under subchapter II of chapter
- 21 73 of title 10, United States Code.
- 22 (2) SBP PREMIUM.—The term "SBP premium"
- 23 means the reduction in retired pay required as a

- 1 condition of providing an annuity under the military
- 2 Survivor Benefit Plan.
