- 3 SECTION 1. MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTION AND MAINTE-
- 4 NANCE IN STATES THAT CONTRACT OUT FOR
- 5 SERVICES.
- 6 Section 182(a)(2)(B) of the Clean Air Act is amended
- 7 by adding the following at the end thereof:

"(iii) Within 12 months after the date of the enactment of this clause, the Administrator shall revise and republish in the Federal Register the guidance for the States for motor vehicle inspection and maintenance programs required by this Act to establish additional requirements applicable to States that contract out emissions testing and inspection services to a private vendor. No later than 2 years after the Administrator publishes such revised guidance, each State that contracts out emissions testing and inspection services shall submit a revision of such program to meet the requirements of such revised guidance. The revised guidance shall require such programs to use a voucher system for vehicle inspection. Vehicle owners may use the voucher to have a vehicle inspected either by the State's chosen vendor for emissions testing and vehicle inspection services, or by choosing to use the voucher to defray a portion of the cost of an inspection by a private concern licensed to do emissions tests and car inspections. The State shall estimate the cost of vehicle inspection, varying the price for different vehicles. The value of the voucher shall be equal to the reimbursement rate per vehicle established under the State's
