- 3 Section 4(b) of the Occupational Safety and Health
- 4 Act of 1970 (29 U.S.C. 653(b)) is amended by adding at
- 5 the end the following:
- 6 "(5) Nothing in this Act shall apply to employment
- 7 performed in a workplace which is located in the residence
- 8 of the employee engaged in such employment.".
