## A BILL

To amend the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 to provide that the Act will not apply to employment performed in a workplace located in the employee's residence.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Home Office Protec-  
5 tion Enhancement Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. APPLICATION OF OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND**  
2 **HEALTH ACT OF 1970.**

3 Section 4(b) of the Occupational Safety and Health  
4 Act of 1970 (29 U.S.C. 653(b)) is amended by adding at  
5 the end the following:

6 “(5) Nothing in this Act shall apply to employment  
7 performed in a workplace which is located in the residence  
8 of the employee engaged in such employment.”.
