To amend title 18 of the United States Code to clarify the provisions respecting forfeiture for alien smuggling.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FORFEITURE FOR ALIEN SMUGGLING.
- 4 Section 981(a)(1) of title 18, United States Code, is
- 5 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 6 "(G)(i) Any conveyance, including any vessel,
- 7 vehicle, or aircraft which has been used or is being
- 8 used in commission of a violation of section 274(a)
- 9 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 10 1324(a); and

1	"(ii) Any property, real or personal that—
2	"(I) constitutes, is derived from, or is
3	traceable to the proceeds obtained, directly or
4	indirectly, from the commission of a violation of
5	section 274(a) of the Immigration and Nation-
6	ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1324(a)); or
7	"(II) is used to facilitate, or is intended to
8	be used to facilitate, the commission of a viola-
9	tion of such section.".
