5 mately 6 miles east of Sandy Hook, New Jersey, and
6 known as the “Historic Area Remediation Site” shall be
7 known and designated as the “Albert Gore, Jr., Mud
8 Dump Site”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the site re-
4 ferred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the “Albert Gore, Jr., Mud Dump Site”.
