A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to provide that covered beneficiaries under chapter 55 of such title shall not be required to pay a copayment for health care services received under TRICARE Prime.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION. 1. ELIMINATION OF COPAYMENTS UNDER**
4 **TRICARE PRIME.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 55 of title 10, United
6 States Code, is amended in section 1095d by adding at
7 the end the following new subsection:

1 “(c) TERMINATION OF COPAYMENTS FOR COVERED
2 BENEFICIARIES.—The Secretary may not require a cov-
3 ered beneficiary to pay a copayment for health care serv-
4 ices received under TRICARE Prime.”.

5 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENTS.—(1) The heading of
6 such section is amended to read as follows:

7 **“§ 1095d. TRICARE program: waiver of certain**
8 **deductibles and copayments”.**

9 (2) The item relating to section 1095d in the table
10 of sections at the beginning of such chapter is amended
11 to read as follows:

“1095d. TRICARE program: waiver of certain deductibles and copayments.”.

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
