- 7 the end the following new subsection:

- 1 "(c) Termination of Copayments for Covered
- 2 Beneficiaries.—The Secretary may not require a cov-
- 3 ered beneficiary to pay a copayment for health care serv-
- 4 ices received under TRICARE Prime.".
- 5 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENTS.—(1) The heading of
- 6 such section is amended to read as follows:
- 7 "§ 1095d. TRICARE program: waiver of certain
- 8 deductibles and copayments".
- 9 (2) The item relating to section 1095d in the table
- 10 of sections at the beginning of such chapter is amended
- 11 to read as follows:

"1095d. TRICARE program: waiver of certain deductibles and copayments.".
