A BILL

To require the Attorney General and the Secretary of the Treasury to operate the land border port of entry located in Pittsburg, New Hampshire, as a full-time port of entry.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FULL-TIME OPERATION OF NEW HAMPSHIRE**
4 **PORT OF ENTRY.**

5 The Attorney General, with respect to all immigra-
6 tion and other border crossing functions performed by the
7 Attorney General, and the Secretary of the Treasury, with

1 respect to all customs and other border crossing functions
2 performed by the Secretary, shall take such actions as may
3 be necessary to ensure that the land border port of entry
4 located in Pittsburg, New Hampshire, is open full-time
5 (24 hours a day, 365 days a year) and has adequate per-
6 sonnel to perform such functions at such port of entry.
