## A BILL

To require the Attorney General and the Secretary of the Treasury to operate the land border port of entry located in Pittsburg, New Hampshire, as a full-time port of entry.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FULL-TIME OPERATION OF NEW HAMPSHIRE
- 4 PORT OF ENTRY.
- 5 The Attorney General, with respect to all immigra-
- 6 tion and other border crossing functions performed by the
- 7 Attorney General, and the Secretary of the Treasury, with

- 1 respect to all customs and other border crossing functions
- 2 performed by the Secretary, shall take such actions as may
- 3 be necessary to ensure that the land border port of entry
- 4 located in Pittsburg, New Hampshire, is open full-time
- 5 (24 hours a day, 365 days a year) and has adequate per-
- 6 sonnel to perform such functions at such port of entry.
