## A BILL

To amend the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 to provide that the Act will not apply to employment performed in a workplace located in the employee's residence unless the employment involves hazardous materials or the workplace was created so that that Act would not apply to the workplace.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. APPLICATION OF OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND**  
2 **HEALTH ACT OF 1970.**

3 Section 4(b) of the Occupational Safety and Health  
4 Act of 1970 (29 U.S.C. 653(b)) is amended by adding at  
5 the end the following:

6 “(5) Nothing in this Act shall apply to employment  
7 performed in a workplace which is located in the residence  
8 of the employee engaged in such employment unless—

9 “(A) the employment involves hazardous mate-  
10 rials; or

11 “(B) the workplace was created so that this Act  
12 would not apply to the workplace.”.
