A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to allow distilled spirits to be produced in dwelling houses, other connected structures, and certain other premises.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION. 1. REPEAL OF PROHIBITION OF PRODUCTION OF**
4 **DISTILLED SPIRITS ON CERTAIN PREMISES.**

5 (a) REPEAL.—Section 5178(a)(1) of the Internal
6 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—

7 (1) by striking subparagraph (B); and

1 (2) by redesignating subparagraph (C) as sub-
2 paragraph (B).

3 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

4 (1) Section 5601(a) of such Code (relating to
5 criminal penalties) is amended by striking paragraph
6 (6).

7 (2) Section 5178(b) of such Code is amended
8 by striking “(not specifically prohibited by section
9 5601(a)(6))”.

10 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
11 this Act shall take effect on the date of the enactment
12 of this Act.
