- 3 SECTION. 1. REPEAL OF PROHIBITION OF PRODUCTION OF
- 4 DISTILLED SPIRITS ON CERTAIN PREMISES.
- 5 (a) Repeal.—Section 5178(a)(1) of the Internal
- 6 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—
- 7 (1) by striking subparagraph (B); and

(2) by redesignating subparagraph (C) as sub-1 2 paragraph (B). 3 (b) Conforming Amendments.— 4 (1) Section 5601(a) of such Code (relating to 5 criminal penalties) is amended by striking paragraph (6).6 (2) Section 5178(b) of such Code is amended 7 by striking "(not specifically prohibited by section 8 9 5601(a)(6))". (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by 10 this Act shall take effect on the date of the enactment 12 of this Act.
