  - 5 The Executive Draft on Federal Transportation in
- 6 the National Capital Region which has been submitted to
- 7 the Office of Management and Budget by the Secretary

- 1 of Transportation shall take effect on the date of enact-
- 2 ment of this Act.
- 3 SEC. 2. REPORT TO CONGRESS.
- 4 Not later than 60 days after the date of enactment
- 5 of this Act, the Secretary of Transportation shall transmit
- 6 to Congress a report on the implementation of Executive
- 7 Draft referred to in section 1.
