 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Logan Reclamation
 - 5 and Stabilization Act".

1 SEC. 2. DESIGNATION.

- 2 The Administrator of the Environmental Protection
- 3 Agency shall designate the Logan Triangle in Philadel-
- 4 phia, Pennsylvania, as a brownfield site for purposes of
- 5 the brownfields economic redevelopment initiative of the
- 6 Environmental Protection Agency.

7 SEC. 3. LOGAN TRIANGLE DEFINED.

- 8 In this Act, the term "Logan Triangle" means the
- 9 area of the city of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, that is des-
- 10 ignated by the city as the Logan Triangle and that is
- 11 bounded on the south by Wingohocking Street and Roo-
- 12 sevelt Boulevard, on the east by Marshall Street, on the
- 13 north by Loudon Street, and by 11th Street on the west.
