AN ACT

To amend title 18, United States Code, to ban partial-birth abortions.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- ${\it 2\ tives\ of\ the\ United\ States\ of\ America\ in\ Congress\ assembled},$

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Partial-Birth Abortion
- 3 Ban Act of 2000".
- 4 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON PARTIAL-BIRTH ABORTIONS.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title 18, United States Code, is
- 6 amended by inserting after chapter 73 the following:

7 "CHAPTER 74—PARTIAL-BIRTH ABORTIONS

"Sec.

"1531. Partial-birth abortions prohibited.

8 "§ 1531. Partial-birth abortions prohibited

- 9 "(a) Any physician who, in or affecting interstate or
- 10 foreign commerce, knowingly performs a partial-birth
- 11 abortion and thereby kills a human fetus shall be fined
- 12 under this title or imprisoned not more than 2 years, or
- 13 both. This paragraph shall not apply to a partial-birth
- 14 abortion that is necessary to save the life of a mother
- 15 whose life is endangered by a physical disorder, illness,
- 16 or injury. This paragraph shall become effective 1 day
- 17 after the enactment.
- 18 "(b)(1) As used in this section, the term 'partial-birth
- 19 abortion' means an abortion in which the person per-
- 20 forming the abortion deliberately and intentionally—
- 21 "(A) vaginally delivers some portion of an in-
- tact living fetus until the fetus is partially outside
- 23 the body of the mother, for the purpose of per-
- forming an overt act that the person knows will kill

- 1 the fetus while the fetus is partially outside the body
- 2 of the mother; and
- 3 "(B) performs the overt act that kills the fetus
- 4 while the intact living fetus is partially outside the
- 5 body of the mother.
- 6 "(2) As used in this section, the term 'physician'
- 7 means a doctor of medicine or osteopathy legally author-
- 8 ized to practice medicine and surgery by the State in
- 9 which the doctor performs such activity, or any other indi-
- 10 vidual legally authorized by the State to perform abor-
- 11 tions: Provided, however, That any individual who is not
- 12 a physician or not otherwise legally authorized by the
- 13 State to perform abortions, but who nevertheless directly
- 14 performs a partial-birth abortion, shall be subject to the
- 15 provisions of this section.
- 16 "(c)(1) The father, if married to the mother at the
- 17 time she receives a partial-birth abortion procedure, and
- 18 if the mother has not attained the age of 18 years at the
- 19 time of the abortion, the maternal grandparents of the
- 20 fetus, may in a civil action obtain appropriate relief, unless
- 21 the pregnancy resulted from the plaintiff's criminal con-
- 22 duct or the plaintiff consented to the abortion.
- 23 "(2) Such relief shall include—

- 1 "(A) money damages for all injuries, psycho-
- 2 logical and physical, occasioned by the violation of
- 3 this section; and
- 4 "(B) statutory damages equal to three times
- 5 the cost of the partial-birth abortion.
- 6 "(d)(1) A defendant accused of an offense under this
- 7 section may seek a hearing before the State Medical Board
- 8 on whether the physician's conduct was necessary to save
- 9 the life of the mother whose life was endangered by a
- 10 physical disorder, illness or injury.
- 11 "(2) The findings on that issue are admissible on that
- 12 issue at the trial of the defendant. Upon a motion of the
- 13 defendant, the court shall delay the beginning of the trial
- 14 for not more than 30 days to permit such a hearing to
- 15 take place.
- 16 "(e) A woman upon whom a partial-birth abortion is
- 17 performed may not be prosecuted under this section, for
- 18 a conspiracy to violate this section, or for an offense under
- 19 section 2, 3, or 4 of this title based on a violation of this
- 20 section.".
