## A BILL

To prohibit further extension or establishment of any national monument in Washington State without full public participation and an express Act of Congress, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Local Input Protection  
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON FURTHER EXTENSION OR ESTAB-**  
2 **LISHMENT OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS IN**  
3 **WASHINGTON STATE.**

4 No extension or establishment of a national monu-  
5 ment may be undertaken in Washington State after the  
6 date of enactment of this Act without full public participa-  
7 tion and an express Act of Congress.
