## A BILL

To provide for direct payment by foreign students of the information fee under section 641 of the Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1997.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DIRECT PAYMENT BY FOREIGN STUDENTS OF**  
4 **INFORMATION FEE UNDER SECTION 641 OF**  
5 **THE IMMIGRATION REFORM AND IMMIGRANT**  
6 **RESPONSIBILITY ACT OF 1997.**

7 Section 641(e) of the Immigration Reform and Immi-  
8 grant Responsibility Act of 1997 (division C of Public Law  
9 104–208) is amended—

1           (1) in paragraph (1), by inserting “subject to  
2       paragraph (5),” after “Beginning on April 1,  
3       1997,”;

4           (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “An ap-  
5       proved” and inserting “Subject to paragraph (5), an  
6       approved”; and

7           (3) by adding at the end the following new  
8       paragraph:

9           “(5) REMITTANCE BY FOREIGN STUDENT.—Ef-  
10       fective for aliens first registering (or commencing ac-  
11       tivities in the United States) with an institution or  
12       program after the date of the enactment of this  
13       paragraph, the fee under paragraph (1) shall be re-  
14       mitted directly by the alien involved to the Attorney  
15       General (pursuant to a schedule established by the  
16       Attorney General) and shall no longer be imposed or  
17       collected by the institution of higher education or  
18       designated exchange visitor program involved.”.
