A BILL

To provide for direct payment by foreign students of the information fee under section 641 of the Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1997.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. DIRECT PAYMENT BY FOREIGN STUDENTS OF

INFORMATION FEE UNDER SECTION 641 OF

THE IMMIGRATION REFORM AND IMMIGRANT

RESPONSIBILITY ACT OF 1997.

Section 641(e) of the Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1997 (division C of Public Law

104–208) is amended—

- 1 (1) in paragraph (1), by inserting "subject to 2 paragraph (5)," after "Beginning on April 1, 3 1997,";
 - (2) in paragraph (2), by striking "An approved" and inserting "Subject to paragraph (5), an approved"; and
 - (3) by adding at the end the following new paragraph:
 - "(5) Remittance by foreign student.—Effective for aliens first registering (or commencing activities in the United States) with an institution or program after the date of the enactment of this paragraph, the fee under paragraph (1) shall be remitted directly by the alien involved to the Attorney General (pursuant to a schedule established by the Attorney General) and shall no longer be imposed or collected by the institution of higher education or designated exchange visitor program involved.".
