- 5 (a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
- 6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
- 7 amended in heading 9902.71.08 by striking "On or before
- 8 12/31/2000" and inserting "On or before 12/31/2003".
- 9 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 10 this section applies with respect to goods entered, or with-

- 1 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the
- 2 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
