A BILL

To temporarily suspend the duty on certain Reactive Red 180 solutions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.32.71	Reactive Red 180, in 15 percent solutions used for inkjet applications (CAS No. 85586-40-9) (provided for in subheading 3204.16.50)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2004	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section shall apply to goods entered, or withdrawn
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
