3 **SECTION 1. CORPS OF ENGINEERS OVERSIGHT OF SUPER-**
4 **FUND CONTRACTS.**

5 Section 104 of the Comprehensive Environmental Re-
6 sponse, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 (42

1 U.S.C. 9604) is amended by adding at the end the follow-
2 ing:

3 “(k) CORPS OF ENGINEERS OVERSIGHT OF SUPER-
4 FUND CONTRACTS.—Except in the case of remedial ac-
5 tions carried out by a State or political subdivision under
6 subsection (d), contract administration of awarded con-
7 tracts for design and construction associated with Fund
8 lead remedial actions commenced under this section after
9 the date of the enactment of this subsection shall be per-
10 formed by the United States Army Corps of Engineers.
11 Nothing in this subsection shall be interpreted to affect
12 existing contracts or procedures for awarding any con-
13 tracts under this Act.”.
