3	SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY.
4	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7	new heading:
	" 9902.39.01 Polyvinylchloride (PVC) self-adhesive sheets of a type used to make bandages (provided for in subheading 3919.90.50)

- 2 this section applies to articles entered, or withdrawn from
- 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after

4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
