A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on ortho-cumyl-octylphenol (OCOP).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.29.01	ortho-cumyl-octylphenol (OCOP) (CAS No. 73936-80-8) (provided for in subheading 2907.19.80)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2003	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section applies with respect to goods entered, or with-
3 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the
4 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
