## A BILL

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Alabama.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE AND REINSTATE-4 MENT OF LICENSE.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period
6 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16)

U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-1 2 ergy Regulatory Commission project numbered 7115, the 3 Commission shall, at the request of the licensee for the 4 project, in accordance with the good faith, due diligence, 5 and public interest requirements of that section and the Commission's procedures under that section, extend for 3 6 7 consecutive 2-year periods, the time period during which 8 the licensee is required to commence construction of the 9 project.

10 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall take effect 11 on the expiration of the period required for commencement 12 of construction of the project described in subsection (a). 13 (c) REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSE.—If the license for the project described in subsection (a) has ex-14 15 pired prior to the date of enactment of this Act, the Commission shall reinstate the license effective as of the date 16 17 of its expiration and extend the time required for commencement of construction of the project for not more 18 than 3 consecutive 2-year periods, the first of which shall 19 20 commence on the date of expiration of the license.
