## A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 Any visitor's center or museum for Gettysburg Na-  
5 tional Military Park in the proximity of or within the

1 boundaries of that Park that is constructed or designated  
2 as a visitor's center or museum after the date of the enact-  
3 ment of this Act shall be known and designated as the  
4 "George D. and Emily G. Rosensteel Memorial Visitors'  
5 Center".

6 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

7 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
8 paper, or other record of the United States to a Federal  
9 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be  
10 a reference to the "George D. and Emily G. Rosensteel  
11 Memorial Visitors' Center".
