Mr. GEJDENSON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Army to convey land to the town of Thompson, Connecticut, for fire fighting and emergency services purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO CONVEY LAND, TOWN OF**
4 **THOMPSON, CONNECTICUT.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Army may
6 convey, without consideration, to the town of Thompson,
7 Connecticut, all right, title, and interest of the United
8 States in and to the parcel of land described in subsection

9 (b) for use by the town for fire fighting and related emer-
10 gency services purposes.

1 (b) LAND DESCRIPTION.—The parcel of land re-
2 ferred to in subsection (a) is the parcel, located in the
3 West Thompson Lake project area, identified in the sur-
4 vey, provided by the town of Thompson, on file at the New
5 England District Office of the Corps of Engineers.

6 (c) REVERSION.—

7 (1) IN GENERAL.—If, after making a convey-
8 ance under this section, the Secretary determines
9 that the parcel described in subsection (b) is not
10 being used for fire fighting and related emergency
11 services, all right, title, and interest in and to the
12 parcel shall revert, at the option of the United
13 States, to the United States.

14 (2) PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS.—Any deter-
15 mination made by the Secretary under this sub-
16 section shall be made on the record only after there
17 has been an opportunity for a hearing.

18 (3) RIGHT OF ENTRY.—If the United States ex-
19 ercises its option to seek reversion under paragraph
20 (1), it shall gain an immediate right of entry onto
21 the parcel.

22 (d) APPLICABILITY OF SCREENING PROVISIONS.—
23 Section 2696 of title 10, United States Code, shall not
24 apply to any conveyance under this section.

1 (e) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The
2 Secretary may require that any conveyance under this sec-
3 tion be subject to such additional terms and conditions
4 as the Secretary considers appropriate and necessary to
5 protect the interests of the United States.
