Mrs. MINK of Hawaii introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Appropriations

A BILL

To make appropriations for fiscal year 2000 for a plant genetic conservation program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Plant Genetic Con-
5 servation Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2000”.

6 **SEC. 2. APPROPRIATION FOR PLANT GENETIC CONSERVA-**
7 **TION.**

8 The following sums are appropriated, out of any
9 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for fis-
10 cal year 2000:

1 DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR
2 UNITED STATES FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE
3 PLANT GENETIC CONSERVATION
4 For expenses necessary to carry out a plant genetic
5 conservation program to store material from rare, endan-
6 gered, and threatened plants in Hawaii and other States
7 and areas of the United States, including expenses for
8 construction and maintenance of a temperature-controlled
9 facility for such purpose, \$1,500,000.
