1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCREASE IN AUTHORIZED MAXIMUM ENROLL-**
4 **MENT IN CONSERVATION RESERVE.**

5 Section 1231(d) of the Food Security Act of 1985
6 (16 U.S.C. 3831(d)) is amended by striking “36,400,000
7 acres” and inserting “45,000,000 acres”.
