A BILL

To define the value of items that are used in the production of securities by the Bureau of Engraving and Printing.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Bureau of Engraving
- 5 and Printing Theft Deterrence Act of 2000".
- 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITION OF VALUE OF ITEMS EMBEZZLED OR
- 7 STOLEN.
- 8 Section 642 of title 18, United States Code (relating
- 9 to embezzlement or theft of tools and materials) is amend-
- 10 ed by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

1	"For purposes of this section, the value of the paper,
2	instrument, document, obligation, or security shall be the
3	greater of—
4	"(1) the face value or the intended face value
5	of the paper, instrument, document, obligation, or
6	security, without regard to the extent to which man-
7	ufacture of the paper, instrument, document, obliga-
8	tion, or security has been completed; or
9	"(2) the amount obtained or offered for, or the
10	value of, the paper, instrument, document, obliga-
11	tion, or security.".
