An Act

To reauthorize grants for water resources research and technology institutes established under the Water Resources Research Act of 1984.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of
the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

SECTION 1. WATER RESOURCES RESEARCH PROGRAM GRANTS.

Section 104(f)(1) of the Water Resources Research Act of 1984 (42 U.S.C. 10303(f)(1)) is amended by striking “\$5,000,000 for fiscal year 1996, \$7,000,000 for each of fiscal years 1997 and 1998, and \$9,000,000 for each of fiscal years 1999 and 2000” and inserting “\$9,000,000 for fiscal year 2001, \$10,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2002 and 2003, and \$12,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2004 and 2005”.

**SEC. 2. GRANTS FOR RESEARCH FOCUSED ON WATER PROBLEMS OF
INTERSTATE NATURE.**

The first sentence of section 104(g)(1) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 10303(g)(1)) is amended by striking “\$3,000,000 for each of fiscal years 1996 through 2000” and inserting “\$3,000,000 for fiscal year 2001, \$4,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2002 and 2003, and \$6,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2004 and 2005”.
