A BILL

To amend the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to correct the definition of certain hand-woven wool fabrics.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TARIFF DEFINITION CORRECTION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 51 of the Harmonized
5 Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended by strik-
6 ing subheading 5111.11.70 and inserting in numerical se-
7 quence the following new subheadings and superior text
8 thereto, with such superior text having the same degree

1 of indention as the article description for subheading
 2 5111.11.30:

“	5111.11.65	Other: Hand-woven of yarns of different colors	7 cents/ kg+11% 29.4%	Free (CA, IL, MX) Free (CA, IL, MX)	68.5% 68.5%	”.

3 (b) STAGED RATE REDUCTIONS.—Any staged rate
 4 reduction that was proclaimed by the President before the
 5 date of the enactment of this Act, to take effect on or
 6 after the date of the enactment of this Act—

7 (1) of a rate of duty set forth in subheading
 8 5111.11.30 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of
 9 the United States shall apply to the corresponding
 10 rate of duty in subheading 5111.11.65 of such
 11 Schedule (as added by subsection (a)); and

12 (2) of a rate of duty set forth in subheading
 13 5111.11.70 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of
 14 the United States shall apply to the corresponding
 15 rate of duty in subheading 5111.11.75 of such
 16 Schedule (as added by subsection (a)).

17 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 18 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
 19 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 20 the 30th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
