lowing bill; which was referred to the Committee on Commerce

A BILL

To amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act
relating to the distribution chain of prescription drugs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PRESCRIPTION DRUG DISTRIBUTION.**

4 Section 503(e)(1)(A) of the Federal Food, Drug, and
5 Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 353(e)(1)(A)) is amended—

6 (1) by inserting “for a calendar year” after “or
7 an authorized distributor of record of such drug”;
8 and

1 (2) by inserting “a statement that the drug was
2 first purchased from or through an authorized dis-
3 tributor or” after “who receives the drug”.

4 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZED DISTRIBUTORS.**

5 Section 503(e)(4)(A) of the Federal Food, Drug, and
6 Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 353(e)(4)(A)) is amended by
7 striking “the term” and all that follows and inserting the
8 following: “the term ‘authorized distributor of record’
9 means any distributor to which a manufacturer sells pre-
10 scription drugs during a calendar year, and”.

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
