- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

  SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF MAJOR MEDICAL FACILITY

  PROJECT, DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AF
  FAIRS.

  The Secretary of Veterans Affairs may carry out a

  major medical facility project for the renovation of the De-

- 9 New York, in an amount not to exceed \$12,300,000.

## 1 SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

2	(a) In General.—There are authorized to be appro-
3	priated to the Secretary of Veterans Affairs for fiscal year
4	2001 for the Construction, Major Projects, account
5	\$12,300,000 for the project authorized in section 1.
6	(b) Limitation.—The project authorized in section
7	1 may only be carried out using—
8	(1) funds appropriated for fiscal year 2001 pur-
9	suant to the authorization of appropriations in sub-
10	section (a);
11	(2) funds appropriated for the Construction,
12	Major Projects, account for a fiscal year before fis-
13	cal year 2001 that remain available for obligation;
14	and
15	(3) funds appropriated for the Construction,
16	Major Projects, account for fiscal year 2001 for a
