3 **SECTION. 1. JURISDICTION OF NATIONAL LABOR RELA-**
4 **TIONS BOARD.**

5 Paragraph (1) of section 14(c) of the National Labor
6 Relations Act (29 U.S.C. 164(c)(1)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking the period after “1959”; and

1 (2) by inserting the following: “: *Provided fur-*
2 *ther*, That the Board shall not decline to assert ju-
3 risdiction over a labor dispute which occurs on John-
4 ston Atoll, an unincorporated territory of the United
5 States.”.
