A BILL

To amend part B of title III of the Higher Education Act of 1965 to repeal the specific limitation on the eligibility of the University of the District of Columbia for assistance for Historically Black Colleges and Universities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “University of the Dis-
5 trict of Columbia Equal Educational Status Act of 1999”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF RESTRICTION ON ELIGIBILITY OF UNI-**
2 **VERSITY OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA**
3 **FOR ASSISTANCE FOR HISTORICALLY BLACK**
4 **COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 324(g) of the Higher
6 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1063(g)) is amended—

7 (1) in the heading, by striking “INSTITUTIONS”
8 and inserting “INSTITUTION”;

9 (2) by striking “or the University of the Dis-
10 trict of Columbia”;

11 (3) by striking “or by the University of the Dis-
12 trict of Columbia” and all that follows through “(87
13 Stat. 774)”; and

14 (4) by striking “and the University of the Dis-
15 trict of Columbia, as the case may be,”.

16 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
17 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to fiscal year 2000
18 and each succeeding fiscal year.
