3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Strategic Reserve Re-
- 5 plenishment Act of 1999".

1SEC. 2. ROYALTY IN-KIND-OIL TO FILL THE STRATEGIC PE-2TROLEUM RESERVE.

Beginning not later than 45 days after the date of
the enactment of this Act, the Director of the Minerals
Management Service shall accept royalty-in-kind oil from
the Gulf of Mexico at a rate of not less than 100,000 barrels per day to fill the Strategic Petroleum Reserve, and
shall continue accepting such oil until the Secretary of Energy certifies to Congress that the Strategic Petroleum
Reserve is at its holding capacities.
