A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fair Steel Trade Act".

1	SEC. 2. TEMPORARY BAN ON IMPORTS OF STEEL AND
2	STEEL PRODUCTS FROM CERTAIN COUN-
3	TRIES.
4	For the 3-month period beginning on the seventh day
5	after the date of the enactment of this Act, no steel or
6	steel product that is the product of Japan, Russia, South
7	Korea, or Brazil may be imported into, or enter the cus-
8	toms territory of, the United States.
