Mr. TRAFICANT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To designate the Youngstown-Warren area of Ohio as an empowerment zone under subchapter U of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF YOUNGSTOWN-WARREN AREA**
4 **OF OHIO AS AN EMPOWERMENT ZONE.**

5 Section 1391(g) of the Internal Revenue Code of
6 1986 is amended by adding at the end the following new
7 paragraph:

8 “(4) DESIGNATION OF YOUNGSTOWN-WARREN
9 AREA.—

1 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Youngstown-War-
2 ren area of Ohio is hereby designated as an em-
3 powerment zone under this subchapter.

4 “(B) DEFINITION OF YOUNGSTOWN-WAR-
5 REN AREA.—For purposes of this paragraph,
6 the Youngstown-Warren area of Ohio is the
7 area covered by the application submitted on
8 October 5, 1998, by the State of Ohio and the
9 local governments of Youngstown, Ohio, and
10 Warren, Ohio, to the Secretary of Housing and
11 Urban Development for designation as an em-
12 powerment zone in an urban area under this
13 subchapter.

14 “(C) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The designation
15 made by this paragraph shall take effect as of
16 December 31, 1998.”.
