- 3 SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF YOUNGSTOWN-WARREN AREA

- 6 1986 is amended by adding at the end the following new
- 7 paragraph:
- 8 "(4) Designation of Youngstown-Warren
- 9 AREA.—

1	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The Youngstown-War-
2	ren area of Ohio is hereby designated as an em-
3	powerment zone under this subchapter.
4	"(B) Definition of Youngstown-War-
5	REN AREA.—For purposes of this paragraph.

"(B) DEFINITION OF YOUNGSTOWN-WAR-REN AREA.—For purposes of this paragraph, the Youngstown-Warren area of Ohio is the area covered by the application submitted on October 5, 1998, by the State of Ohio and the local governments of Youngstown, Ohio, and Warren, Ohio, to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development for designation as an empowerment zone in an urban area under this subchapter.

"(C) Effective date.—The designation made by this paragraph shall take effect as of December 31, 1998.".
