## A BILL

1	SECTION 1. CONSIDERATION OF UNEMPLOYMENT AND
2	POVERTY RATES IN EVALUATING APPLICA-
3	TIONS FOR DESIGNATION OF EMPOWERMENT
4	ZONES IN URBAN AREAS.
5	(a) In General.—Subsection (c) of section 1392 of
6	the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by adding
7	at the end the following:
8	"In weighing the factors taken into account in the evalua-
9	tion of an application for the designation of an empower-
10	ment zone in an urban area, the unemployment rate and
11	the poverty rate of the nominated area shall together be
12	given half the weight.".
13	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
14	subsection (a) shall take effect with respect to applications
15	submitted after the date of the enactment of this Act.
