- 6 scribed in subsection (b): Provided, That all minerals un-
- 7 derlying such land are hereby reserved to the United
- 8 States.
- 9 (b) Land Description.—The land referred to in
- 10 subsection (a) is the approximately 40-acre parcel located
- 11 in the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 11, Township 51 North,
- 12 Range 96 West, 6th Principal Meridian, Wyoming.
