A BILL

To provide for the liquidation or reliquidation of certain customs entries of nuclear fuel assemblies.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. RELIQUIDATION OF CERTAIN NUCLEAR FUEL
- 4 ASSEMBLIES.
- 5 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding section 514 of
- 6 the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other pro-
- 7 vision of law, upon proper request filed with the Secretary
- 8 of the Treasury not later than 90 days after the date of
- 9 the enactment of this Act, the Secretary—

- 1 (1) shall reliquidate as free of duty the entries 2 listed in subsection (b); and 3 (2) shall refund any duties paid with respect to 4 each such entry, including duties paid on October 4, 5 1996, Customs Service Collection Receipt Number 6 527006753.
