8 Section 4 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.9 633(a)) is amended—

(1) in the third sentence, by striking "branch
 and regional" and inserting "regional, district, and
 branch"; and

4 (2) by inserting after the second sentence the
5 following: "The Administration shall establish not
6 less than 1 district office of the Administration in
7 each of the several States.".
