13	(a) Sense of Congress.—It is the sense of Con-
14	gress that, if the Secretary of the Navy should reduce the
15	number of operational Trident ballistic missile submarines
16	from the current 18 to 14, then the amount otherwise pro-
17	grammed for national missile defense programs for any
18	fiscal year after such reduction should be increased by the
19	amount saved during that fiscal year by reason of such
20	reduction.
21	(b) Amounts To Be Included as Savings.—In de-
22	termining the amount saved by reason of a reduction in
23	operational Trident submarines described in subsection
24	(a), there shall be included amounts saved due to the sub-
25	marines taken out of service not being backfitted to carry
26	D-5 missiles or refueled and otherwise modernized and

- 2 marines not being procured.
