A BILL

For the relief of Henry Johnson.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the time limitations specified in section 3744(b) of
4 title 10, United States Code, shall not apply with respect
5 to awarding a medal of honor under section 3741 of such
6 title to Henry Johnson (service number 10–33–48) for
7 acts of heroism during World War I while a sergeant in
8 the United States Army.
