## A BILL

To require the Inspector General of the Department of Defense to conduct an audit of purchases of military clothing and related items during fiscal year 1998 by certain military installations of the Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marine Corps.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. AUDIT OF PROCUREMENT OF MILITARY
- 4 CLOTHING AND CLOTHING-RELATED ITEMS
- 5 BY CERTAIN MILITARY INSTALLATIONS.
- 6 (a) Audit Requirement.—The Inspector General
- 7 of the Department of Defense shall perform an audit of

- 1 purchases of military clothing and clothing-related items
- 2 in excess of the micro-purchase threshold during fiscal
- 3 year 1998 by certain military installations to determine
- 4 the extent to which such installations procured military
- 5 clothing and clothing-related items in violation of the Buy
- 6 American Act (41 U.S.C. 10a et seq.) and section 9005
- 7 of Public Law 102–396 (10 U.S.C. 2241 note) during that
- 8 fiscal year.
- 9 (b) Installations To Be Audited.—The audit
- 10 under subsection (a)—
- 11 (1) shall include an audit of the procurement of
- military clothing and clothing-related items by four
- military installations of each of the Army, Navy, Air
- 14 Force, and Marine Corps; and
- 15 (2) shall be limited to military installations in
- the United States or the possessions or Territories
- of the United States.
- 18 (c) Definition.—As used in subsection (a), the term
- 19 "micro-purchase threshold" has the meaning provided by
- 20 32(f) of the Office of Federal Procurement Policy Act (41
- 21 U.S.C. 428(f)).
- 22 (d) Report.—Not later than September 30, 2000,
- 23 the Inspector General of the Department of Defense shall

- 1 submit to Congress a report on the results of the audit
- 2 performed under subsection (a).
